Hilton and Sheraton workers:

**Register for your Strike Benefits!**

September 6, 7, 8 and 9, 5:30 am to 7:30 pm

All Sheratons and Hilton workers should come to the Union office and register for their strike benefit debit card. Just like your ATM card, a strike benefit debit card can be used at any ATM, grocery store, Longs, etc. The Union Hall will be open for four days, 14 hours a day, to make registration easy and as fast as possible.

### Picket Duty sign-ups

As of September 1st, 2,692 Sheraton and Hilton workers have signed up for picket duty in the event of a strike.

### Solidarity Pledges

Hyatt, Marriott, Ala Moana, Ilikai and Kahala are not just standing by as their brothers and sisters at Sheraton

and Hilton get ready to strike. On the day of the strike vote, 566 workers from the other '06 properties signed up to picket four hours a week and pledge \$5 a week in the event of a strike at either property. Solidarity Pledge sign-ups continue at all five properties.

Signing a solidarity pledge is the clearest way to tell all of our employers that in Local 5, no one stands alone. It is also the clearest way to let your managers know that we are prepared to do what it takes in all of our properties to win a future for Hawaii hotel workers - to win a Hawaii that our children can live in.

## Chicago settles 4 Hiltons and 4 Hyatts

Tentative agreements have been reached for three year contracts at the Hiltons and Hyatts in Chicago. The settlements include union growth language for both corporations and significant wage and benefit improvements. There is not a single take-away in either tentative agreement.

On Thursday, September 7, our brothers and sisters in Chicago will march on Global Hyatt Headquarters in a demonstration to support Hyatt workers in Honolulu, San Francisco, and Monterey, California, all of whom are currently working without a contract.
